Introduction/Links to Curriculum:

As part of our journey to internationalise education at TMPS, we are hosting 42 students and four staff members from Dali Experimental Primary School from Guangdong, China. Your child (who learns Mandarin) has expressed an interest in engaging and responding as a global citizen and has been randomly selected to participate on this excursion to promote intercultural understandings between our two schools. This is a great opportunity for students to develop an awareness and understanding of different cultural backgrounds, and would equip them with skills for living and working together in an interconnected and diverse world of the 21st century.

On this excursion, students from Thomas Mitchell will be accompanying the students from Dali Experimental Primary School to Moonlit Sanctuary. They will participate in a variety of activities including: Struts, Slithers and Slides, Birds of a Feather, Mammal Mingle, Environmental Games and have the opportunity to feed animals on a Wallaby Walk.

The group will then travel to Frankston Pier and Foreshore and have lunch at Sofia's Restaurant. Lunch, which is paid for by the school, will include a variety of pizzas and pastas to share followed by a scoop of ice cream for dessert.

If time and weather allows, the students will have the opportunity to walk along Frankston Pier and boardwalk and have a play in the playground, which is located at the rear of the restaurant, before returning to school.

Students will be supervised at all times and will not be near the water at any time, except for the walk along the pier.
