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4IW/4JX EXCURSION – MAJOR ROADS PROJECT VICTORIA

9th May 2022

INTRODUCTION/LINKS TO CURRICULUM:

As many people in our community will be aware there are major infrastructure projects currently underway in the Endeavour Hills area. Major Road Projects Victoria (MRPV) and Symal Infrastructure have invited Year 4 students from TMPS to be part of a special road safety initiative on Friday 20th May. This is during National Road Safety Week.

The project team will run a presentation for our students at school to encourage road safety, provide information about the upgrade project and get them excited about the changes happening in the area.

In addition to the presentation, MRPV and Symal will host a site visit to provide students with the opportunity to see what is happening on-site and the various aspects of building a road. They will be accompanied by a safety representative, engineer and communications representative. Hard hats and hi-vis vests will be provided on the day to be worn on the worksite. Students will be given a show bag as well to take home.

Students and staff will walk to and from the site returning to school in time for morning tea. The walk will not be crossing any major roads. No live works will be occurring in the part of the construction zone they will be entering.

Venue/Address:	Students will walk to the construction zone for the site tour (Hallam North Road and Heatherton Road, Endeavour Hills).

Turn left out of gates near Room 4/5, cross Cunningham Drive at the school crossing, turn right and continue on Cunningham Drive (cross Armiston Court), turn left onto Thomas Mitchell Drive (cross Barnsley Drive), turn left onto Hallam North Road, enter worksite and continue along Hallam North Road to staging area on corner of Hallam North Road and Heatherton Road to view road works area. Return to school following same route in the opposite direction.

NOTE: The path on Hallam North Road between Thomas Mitchell Drive and Heatherton Road is within a work zone. However, no live works will be underway in the area. There will be no plant or machines present.

Presentation and Question and Answer Session will be held at Thomas Mitchell Primary School in Room 23
